



LITHUANIA [EUROPE]


- Located in the centre of Europe
- Largest cities: Vilnius, Kaunas, Klaipėda, Šiauliai
- Population: ~2.8 mln (~83% Lithuanians)
- Language: Lithuanian, oldest Indo-European language in the world
- Currency: Euro
- Membership: EU, NATO, Schengen Area, etc.
- Predominant religion: Roman Catholic
- Basketball "2nd religion"

KAUNAS

- 2nd largest city in Lithuania
- ~286K inhabitants
- 100 km from the capital, Vilnius (buses and trains travel between cities every 15 minutes)
- City of students (~50K every academic year)
- Low-fare airlines connect Kaunas with many cities in Europe
- European Capital of Culture 2022!

VILNIUS

- Capital of Lithuania
- ~542K inhabitants
- Multicultural city (~58% Lithuanians)
